





Changing Modes	Press MODE to select between Radio, Front AUX, Rear AUX, USB, Bluetooth Modes of operation are shown in the display.	Ma	
Volume	Adjust volume using volume knob.		
Mute	Press 4 to silence the audio. Press 4 again to resume listening at the previously selected volume.		
Auxiliary Inputs	Insert a 3.5mm cable in the units front AUX port, or RCA cables into the rear AUX-IN connectors.	_	
Reset	Press the RESET button to reset the unit back to the factory settings if abnormal operation occurs. The reset button is located on the front panel.	Stor	
Setting the Clock	With the unit on, press and hold DISP until the clock begins to flash, then release. Press TUNE < to adjust the hours and TUNE >> to adjust the minutes. Press DISP momentarily to save the selected time.		
Display	Press DISP to display the clock.		
Audio / Menu	Press volume knob momentarily to select between the audio functions. Press and hold volume knob for more than two seconds to select between the menu functions. Rotate the volume knob left/right to adjust or activate the desired function/audio.

Bluetooth[®] Operation

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Preparation	Before using a Bluetooth device, it must be paired and connected. Ensure that Bluetooth is activated on your device before beginning the pairing process.
Pairing a New Device	The head unit broadcasts the pairing signal constantly when no devices are connected. Complete the pairing sequence from your Bluetooth device. Refer to the owner's manual for your device for more details.

Pairing Additional Devices	If a device is currently connected, press and hold to disconnect the current device before a new device can be paired. Then begin the pairing sequence from the new Bluetooth device.

AM/FM Tuner Operation Seek Tuning Press TUNE << or TUNE >> for more than one second to seek to the next strong station. Press TUNE << or TUNE >> momentarily to move lanual Tuning radio frequency up or down one step at a time. Press and hold to advance quickly. Press **BAND** to select between FM1, FM2, FM3, AM1 Band and AM2 bands. Up to six presets can be programmed for each band, enabling up to 18 FM stations and 12 $\ensuremath{\mathsf{AM}}$ stations to be stored in memory. Up to 18 FM and 12 AM stations can be stored.
