



Never use record cleaning sprays, benzene, thinner, static electricity prevention liquids or any other solvents to clean your discs.




SYSTEM CONNECTION

- ◆ Do not connect the power cord until all other connections have been made.
- ◆ The Home Theater System has a 2ch analog audio output, a S-video output, a digital audio output (optical & coaxial) and a component output. You can choose the appropriate one to connect to your television.

CONNECTING to the TV

Connections should be made as follows:

In the figure below, the VIDEO OUT, S-VIDEO OUT and COMPONENT OUT jacks are shown. If the TV has S-VIDEO IN or COMPONENT IN jacks, you can achieve a more vivid picture by using these connections.




Y/Pb(Cb)/Pr(Cr) connection

If a display device with Y/Pb(Cb)/Pr(Cr) jacks is connected, then you should connect the jacks with three Y/Pb(Cb)/Pr(Cr) cables.




CONNECTING to the ANTENNA

Connect the supplied AM and FM antennas to listen to the radio.



- ♦ In order to improve the signal, move the AM loop antenna away from system and other equipment.
- ◆ Extend the antenna fully.
- ♦ Keep the FM antenna as horizontal as possible after connection.
- ♦ When connecting the supplied AM loop antenna, connect two black cords to the AM and ground jacks as shown below:





lacktriangle If the FM reception is poor, please use a 75 Ω coaxial cable (not supplied) to connect system to an outdoor FM antenna as shown above.

Note: If you connect system with outdoor FM antenna, you should earth the system in order to avoid lightning strike. IMPORTANT: Do not connect the earth wire to gas pipe to prevent gas explosion.

SYSTETUCONNECTION

RADIO FUNCTIONS

- The player has AM and FM radio functions to receive clear radio stations. Operation steps:
- 1. Press the FUNCTION button to change to Radio.
- 2. Then press the STOP/BAND button to select AM or FM signals.
- 3. Press the TUNE button to select the radio station.
- Change stations by pressing the UP or DOWN direction buttons. The display panel will display the radio frequency.
- 2) Select radio stations automatically by pressing the ◀TUNE or ▶TUNE scan buttons. When the station is found, the auto search will stop. If you like the station, press the OK button to memorize this station. If you want to stop searching, press the STOP/BAND button.
- 4. Memorizing radio stations


If you choose a radio station and want to listen to it later, you can press the OK button to memorize it. The memory location number on the display panel flashes twice to show that the memorization has been done. The first memorized station will be put in the first memory location number. If you memorize other radio stations, they will be memorized in the second memory location number, third memory location number, and so on. This player can store 16 AM and 16 FM radio stations. When you memorize the seventeenth ratio station, it will replace the first one, and so on.

- 5. Accessing memorized radio stations
- If you know the memory location number of a radio station you have memorized, you can press the number buttons on the remote control to access it. To access a memory location above 10, press the Dibutton to access the next higher number of memory location, and the IH button to access the next lower number of memory location.
- 6. In radio status, press AUDIO button to change the radio signal into mono signal and MONO in the display panel will be lit. Press it again to resume the original signal, and MONO will go out.
- 7. When listening to the radio, press the MODE button to select three-channel output or six-channel output.

SYSTEM CONNECTION

CONNECTING the SPEAKERS to the PLAYER

Use the supplied cables to connect the player to the speakers. Note that the polarity should be correct. **IMPORTANT:** Do not connect the player to speakers other than those supplied.



DIGITALAWPUEE

The digital amplifier of digital home theatre system has the following outstanding functions:

- 1. Hi-fi amplifying
- 2. Digital audio amplifying
- 3. Reach more than 80% efficiency
- 4. One-channel analog stereo input jack

Operation introduction of digital amplifier:

- 1. Press FUNCTION button to select radio input, external input and DVD input.
- 2. Press MUTE button to turn off amplifying signal output. Press again to resume.
- 3. If you want to adjust the signal of front left/right, subwoofer, center, surround left/right or all signals, press CHANNEL button to shift to the signal needing adjustment and then press VOLUME- or VOLUME+ to adjust to the effect you like. Press Bass Up/Down to raise or lower the volume.
- 4. DVD functions:

- External audio input:
- 1) Press the MODE button to select three-channel output (display panel displays 2.1 CH) or six-channel output (display panel display 5.1 CH).

NORMALOPERATION

Preparation: After connection, turn on the power of relevant equipment and select video input.

1. Turn on the player's power

Press the POWER button on front panel to turn on the power and the player will search for the disc automatically. If there is a disc in, the player will automatically play it.

2. Press EJECT on front panel or OPEN/CLOSE button on remote control to open the disc tray.

3. Load the disc into the disc tray



Load the disc as shown in the figure in order not to damage the player or the disc.

4. Press the EJECT button or OPEN/ CLOSE button to close the disc tray and begin playback.

NOTE: Do not play bad quality or damaged discs as this may damage the lens inside the player.

DVD PLAYBACK

MENU

Normally there is a selecting menu in a DVD disc. You can use the MENU button to enter the selecting menu directly, and use the direction buttons to highlight the item you would like and press the OK button to select it.

TITLE & CHAPTER

Normally there are several titles in a DVD disc, and also there are several chapters in a title. You can select any one of titles or chapters quickly by using the Number buttons to enter the number of the chapter.

LANGUAGE

There are several kinds of audio languages in a DVD disc. When you play a multi-language DVD disc, press the AUDIO button on remote control to select a different audio language.

NOTE: This function is only available for discs that have several audio bitstreams.

NORWALIOPERATION


SUBTITLE

The DVD player can support up to 32 kinds of subtitles. When you play a multi-subtitle disc, press the SUBTITLE button on remote control to select different subtitle.

NOTE: This function is only available for discs that several audio bitstreams have been recorded onto.

ANGLE

The DVD player supports multi-angle function. Multi-angle means that a scene is shot from more than one angle so that audience can watch from any angle. If there are multiples in a scene, you can use the ANGLE button to select the angle you like to enjoy. Press the ANGLE button continuously to view different angles.



VOLUME

During playback, press the VOL+ button to increase the volume and press the VOL- button to

MORWAL OPERATION

CD PLAYBACK

The player will play all tracks for CD discs continuously in default status. You can press the H4 and H1 (PREV/NEXT SKIP) buttons or number buttons to select a certain track.

PICTURE CD PLAYBACK

JPEG playback operation

1. Normal Playback

Place a disc with 'JPEG' in the player. The left column is the menu for last level, and the right is the menu for next level. Use the OK button and the Left/Right direction button to select submenu with picture. Use the Up/Down button to select the contents in the menu.

For example: Use direction buttons to select the name of the picture, and then press the OK button to confirm to play. Many discs have other contents besides pictures.

2. Picture Rotation

It can be operated when the picture is displayed. Once another picture is selected, it will be cancelled automatically.

There are four kinds of rotational modes: Rotate left, Rotate right, Rotate up and Rotate down. You can use direction buttons to select.

3. Zoom

FEATURE button is used to turn on/off zoom and move function.

When this function is turned on, use the 44 and >> buttons to control zoom proportion and TV screen will display relevant proportion. Then you can use directional navigation arrows to move the picture.

When this function is turned off, the picture will resume normal size, and then press the MENU button to return to root menu.

◆ Depending on how the disc was made, a JPEG disc may allow playback, but not rotation or zooming of the images.

STOP


During playback, press the STOP button on remote control to stop playback. For DVD discs, after pressing the STOP button once, pressing the PLAY button will resume play from the stopped point.

PAUSE

Press the PAUSE/STEP button on remote control to pause, and press it repeatedly to achieve frame-by-frame playback.

REPEAT

- 1. Use the REPEAT button to repeat a title, a chapter, a track and a disc respectively according to different discs, and also to cancel repeat.
- 2. Use the A-B button to repeat section A to B. Press it once to set the starting point A, twice to set the ending point B, and the third time to cancel repeat.



Some discs do not support repeat function.

SEARCH BY TIME

You can use the GOTO button to search by time, namely to play from a specific time. During DVD playback, press the GOTO button once and TV screen will display the title or chapter, then you can use number buttons to select any one of them. Press the GOTO button twice, then you can use number buttons to input the time you desired (hour, minute, second), and the player will play from the inputted time.

Some DVD discs do not support search function.

FAST FORWARD & REWIND

Press the ← and → buttons to activate fast forward or rewind.

SLOW FORWARD & REWIND

Press the SLOW button to activate slow forward or rewind.

◆ There is no slow playback function for CD.

PLAYBACKEUNCTIONS

DISC INFORMATION DISPLAY

Press the OSD button on remote control to display the relevant disc information.

PLAY

Press the PLAY button to start playback. Press the POWER button on remote control to enter standby status, and press it again to resume playback status. If there is no operation for a long time, the player will automatically enter screen saver status and then enter standby status.

PROGRAM PLAYBACK

Use the PROGRAM button to activate program playback of DVD and CD discs. Operation steps:

- 1. In stop status, press the PROGRAM button to enter program status.
- 2. Use the number buttons to input contents according to prompts.
- 3. Repeat step 2 to program more contents.
- 4. Use the direction buttons to move cursor to "START" and then press the OK button or the PLAY button to begin the program playback.

ZOOM

To enlarge or reduce the picture, press the FEATURE button on the remote control. Continually pressing the zoom button will change the mode accordingly: Enlarge x2, enlarge x3 and enlarge x4 or reduction x1/2, reduction x1/3 and reduction 1/4 repeat press the FEATURE button on the remote control to resume normal playback.

SETUP MENU

In stop status, press the SETUP button on the remote control and the TV screen will display a main menu. It includes General Setup, Audio Setup, Video Setup, Preference and Password Setup.

Operation steps:

- 1. Press the SETUP button to enter the setup menu.
- 2. Use the UP/DOWN direction buttons to select the item you want to set.
- 3. Press the OK button to enter the submenu.
- 4. Use the UP/DOWN direction button to select the item in submenu, and then press the RIGHT direction button enter it.
- 5. Use the UP/DOWN direction button to select the item you like and press the OK button to confirm. Press the LEFT directional navigation arrows to return to the submenu and then select "MAIN PAGE" to return to the main menu.
- 6. Press the SETUP button to exit from the setup menu.
- Preference will be only effective in stop status.

GENERAL SETUP

The general setup is shown as following:

1. TV Display

Supports Normal/PS, Normal/LB and Wide aspect ratios.

2. Angle Mark

Some chapters in some DVD discs include many different angles. If the angle mark is set to be "On", then there will be a multi-angle mark displaying on the screen when playing the contents with multi-angle. Here you can use ANGLE button to enjoy different angles. If the angle mark is set to be "Off", then there will be no angle mark on the screen.

3. OSD Language

There are English and Chinese for selection. You can select it according to your preference.

4. Captions

Some DVD discs have hidden captions. You can turn on or off the hidden captions by using this item.

SYSTEM SETUP

5. Screen Saver

Choose "ON" and the unit will enter the mode of screen saver automatically if there has been no operation for a period of time.

6. Last Memory

This setting allows you to select 'On' or 'Off'. When you select 'On' and open the disc tray, the player will resume the movies and/or music to your last stop after the disc tray close again.

AUDIO SETUP

- 1. Speaker Setup
- 1) Downmix

Selecting "LT/RT" in the 'Downmix' will alter the audio output into a mixed Dolby output. By selecting 'Stereo' in the 'Downmix' menu, the player will output a common stereo signal. By selecting 'V SURR' in the "Downmix' menu, the player will output virtual surround signal. By selecting 'Off', the player will alter the 5.1 CH audio outputs (now the setups of the center speaker and the rear speaker are effective).

2) Front Speaker

You can select 'Large' or 'Small'.

3) Center Speaker

When 'Downmix' is in 'Off' status, you can set 'Center Speaker' to be 'Large', 'Small' or' Off'.

4) Rear Speaker

When 'DOWNMIX' is in 'Off' status, you can set 'Rear Speaker' to be 'Large' 'Small' or 'Off'.

5) Subwoofer

You can set it to be 'On' or 'Off'.

6) Test Tone

When 'Downmix' is in 'Off' status and the disc is not loaded, this function is available.

7) Dialog

When "Downmix" is in "LT/RT. Stereo", use this item to adjust the dialog volume.

8) Post DRC

When 'Downmix' is not in 'Off' status, Post DRC can be done.

- 2. SPDIF Setup
- 1) SPDIF Output

You can select "SPDIF Off", "SPDIF / RAW" or "SPDIF / PCM". "SPDIF Off" indicates that the SPDIF signal output to amplifier is turned off. "SPDIF / RAW" indicates raw code is output to amplifier. "SPDIF / PCM" indicates PCM channel signal is output to speakers that has only two output channels.

2) PCM Channel

When SPDIF / PCM is selected, you can select "SPDIF L/R", "SPDIF LS/RS" or "SPDIF C/LFE" for PCM channel." SPDIF L/R" indicates to select channel left/right; "SPDIF LS/RS" indicates to select surround left/right; "SPDIF C/LFE" indicates to select central or subwoofer channel.

3) LPCM Out

You can select "48K", "96K" or "192K".

- 3. Dolby Digital Setup
- 1) Dual Mono

This function is used to set audio output: Stereo, L-Mono, R-Mono and Mix-Mono.

2) Dynamic

The Dynamic Range Compression can be turned off by selecting 'Off' from the submenu, or set to full compression by selecting 'Full'. There are also intermediate levels of compression available for selection.

4. 3D Processing

PRO Logic #

Press PLAY button to activate setup selection mode and then press up/down direction button to select "On, Off, Auto". If the player is playing 2ch music, then the music will be output in 5ch virtual sound and the music can be played with multi-channel speaker. Selecting "Off", this function would not be available. If TITLE does not support this function and you use it, then the effect will be poor. You should set the PRO Logic | in "Auto".

5. HDCD

Filter

This setting allows you to select 'Off', 44.1K or 88.2k.

1) Video

You can select CVBS. YUV and RGB in it.

- Saturation

SYSTEM SETUE

PREFERENCE

1. TV Type

Different countries or areas have different TV systems. You can select relevant video systems according to the TV system in your area. If your TV is with multi-system, then it is suggested to set to be "Multi" which means the video system will be the same as the disc system.

2. Audio

There are several audio languages in some DVD discs. If there is no specific prescript in the disc, then the set audio language will have the priority to be played first. "Others" can be selected according the contents of the disc.

3. Subtitle

There are several subtitle languages in some DVD discs. If there is no specific prescript in the disc, then the set subtitle language will have the priority to be played first. "Others" can be selected according to the contents of the disc.

4. Disc Menu

There are several multi-language signals in some DVD discs. If there is no specific prescript in the disc, then the set menu language will have the priority to be played first. "Others" can be selected according the contents of the disc.

5. Parental

DVD discs with parental function are divided into several levels. You can select relevant level according to the disc and your desire.

6. Default

Use this function to reset all the setting.

7. Version

PASSWORD SETUP.

1) Password Mode

You can select On or Off.

- 2) Password (Change)
- a. Press number buttons to input the original password 136900.
- b. If you input an incorrect password, please input the original password again until the password can be corrected.
- c. Press number buttons to input the new password.
