1 disc playback

- Playback starts automatically.




3 connecting the speakers

- 1. Press down the terminal tab on the back of the speaker.
- 2. Insert the black wire into the black terminal (-) and the red wire into the red (+) terminal, and then release the tab.
- 3. Connect the connecting plugs to the back of the Home Theater.
- Make sure the colors of the speaker terminals match the colors of the connecting





- Do not let children play with or near the speakers. They could get hurt if a speaker falls.
 - When connecting the speaker wires to the speakers, make sure that the polarity (+/-) is correct.
 - Keep the subwoofer speaker out of reach of children so as to prevent children from inserting their hands or alien substances into the duct (hole) of the subwoofer speaker.
 - Do not hang the subwoofer on a wall through the duct (hole).









4 connecting the video out to your tv

Choose one of the three methods for connecting to a TV.



METHOD 1: HDMI

Connect the HDMI cable from the HDMI OUT jack on the back of the DVD Home Theater to the HDMI IN jack on your TV.

METHOD 2 : Component Video

If your television is equipped with Component Video inputs, connect a component video cable(not supplied) from the Component Video Output (Pr, Pb and Y) Connectors on the back of the main unit to the Component Video Input Connectors on your TV.

METHOD 3 : Composite Video

Connect the supplied video cable from the VIDEO OUT jack on the back of the main unit to the VIDEO IN jack on your TV.




- Resolutions available for the HDMI output are 480p, 720p,1080i/1080p.
- This product operates in Interlace scan mode (480i) for Component Output.
- After making the video connection, set the Video input source on your TV to match the corresponding Video output (HDMI, Component or Composite) on your Home theater. See your TV owner's manual for more information on how to select the TV's Video Input source.
- If you use an HDMI cable to connect a Samsung TV to the main unit, you can operate the Home Theater using the TV's remote control. (This is only available with SAMSUNG TVs that support Anynet+(HDMI-CEC).)
- Please check the Anynet logo (If your TV has an Anynet logo, then it supports Anynet+ function.)

5 connecting audio from external components

AUX1: Connecting an External Component/MP3 player

Components such as an MP3 Player.

- 1. Connect AUX IN 1 (Audio) on the Home Theater to the Audio Out of the external component/MP3 player.
- 2. Press the AUX button on the remote control to select AUX1 input.
- You can also use the **FUNCTION** button on the main unit. The mode switches as follows: $DVD/CD \rightarrow D.IN \rightarrow AUX 1 \rightarrow AUX 2 \rightarrow USB \rightarrow FM.$




AUX2: Connecting an External Analog Component

Analog signal components such as a VCR.

- 1. Connect AUX IN 2 (Audio) on the Home Theater to the Audio Out of the external analog component.
- Be sure to match connector colors.
- 2. Press the AUX button on the remote control to select AUX 2 input.
- You can also use the **FUNCTION** button on the main unit. The mode switches as follows:

 $DVD/CD \rightarrow D.IN \rightarrow AUX 1 \rightarrow AUX 2 \rightarrow USB \rightarrow FM$



You can connect the Video Output jack of your VCR to the TV, and connect the Audio Output jacks of the VCR to this product.


OPTICAL: Connecting an External Digital Component

Digital signal components such as a Cable Box/Satellite receiver (Set-Top Box)

- 1. Connect the Digital Input (OPTICAL) on the Home Theater to the Digital Output of the external digital component.
- 2. Press the AUX button on the remote control to select DIGITAL IN.
- You can also use the **FUNCTION** button on the main unit.

The mode switches as follows:



Connecting the FM Antenna

- **1.** Connect the FM antenna supplied to the FM 75Ω COAXIAL Jack.
- 2. Slowly move the antenna wire around until you find a location where reception is good, then fasten it to a wall or other rigid





This unit does not receive AM broadcasts.

Listening to Radio

Remote Control

- 1. Press the TUNER button to select the FM band.
- 2. Tune in to the desired station.
- Automatic Tuning 1: When the I≪,►►I button is pressed, a preset broadcast station is selected.
- Automatic Tuning 2: Press and hold the A, V button to automatically search for active broadcasting stations.
- Manual Tuning: Briefly press the A, V button to increase or decrease the frequency incrementally.

Main Unit

- 1. Press the FUNCTION button to select the FM band
- Select a broadcast station.
- Automatic Tuning 1: Press the STOP (□) button to select PRESET and then press the I←,≯ button to select the
- Automatic Tuning 2 : Press the STOP (□) button to select MANUAL and then press and hold the I◄, ►>I button to
- Manual Tuning: Press the STOP (□) button to select MANUAL and then briefly press the I button to tune in to a lower or higher frequency.
