






2 Place the TV face down on a soft and flat surface (blanket, foam, cloth, etc), to prevent any damage to the TV.

(Bottom view)




TROUBLESHOOTING

Please make these simple checks before calling service. These tips may save you time and money since charging for receiver installation and adjustments of customer controls are not covered under your warranty.

Symptoms	Items to Check and Actions to Follow
"Ghost" or double image	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This may be caused by obstruction to the antenna due to high rise buildings or hills. Using a highly directional antenna may improve the picture.
No power	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Check if the TV's AC power cord is plugged into the outlet. Unplug the TV, wait for 60 seconds. Then reinsert plug into the outlet and turn on the TV again.
No picture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Check antenna connections at the rear of the TV to see if it is properly connected to the TV. Possible broadcast station trouble. Try another channel. Adjust the contrast and brightness settings. Check the Closed Captions control. Some TEXT modes could block the screen.
Good picture but no sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Increase the volume level by pressing the VOL + button on the remote control or on the TV side control panel. Press the MUTE button on the remote control to ensure mute is off.
Good sound but poor color	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Adjust the contrast, color and brightness settings.
Poor picture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Poor picture quality may occur when an activated S-VHS camera or camcorder is connected to your TV and other peripherals at the same time. Switch off one of the peripherals.
Snowy picture and noise	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Check the antenna connection.
Horizontal dotted line	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This may be caused by electrical interference (e.g. hair dryer, nearby neon lights, etc.) Turn off the equipment.
Television not responding to remote control	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Check whether the batteries are working. Replace if necessary. Clean the remote control sensor lens on the TV. You can still use the buttons on the side of your TV.
Pixels(dots) that are always dark or always lit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your TV is precision-manufactured using an extremely high level of technology. However, sometimes pixels may not display correctly. These types of occurrences are inherent to this type of product and do not constitute a defective product.

5. Press **BACK** button return to the previous menu.


ADD AND USE OF MULTI MEDIA PLAYER

1. In the HOME interface, select the + icon in the APP column to add the application, and click **OK**. Press the **←/→** button to select the Multimedia Player application, and click **OK** to add it to the HOME interface.
2. Select **OK** button to enter Multimedia Player and display Video, Photo, Music, Text. After inserting the USB flash drive, you can view the corresponding files in the USB flash drive.

Picture Mode - Press **▲/▼** button to select the option button to enter the sub-menu.



Speaker Delay - Press **▲/▼** button to select the option. Press **←** to decrease the parameter. Press **→** to increase the parameter.







- ⏻/OK**

Under the menu page, you can move the cursor up and down.

In the non-menu page, under the menu page, press the left and right keys to adjust the volume addition and subtraction.


PRECAUTIONS AND REMINDERS

- High voltages are used in the operation of this television receiver. Do not remove the cabinet back from your set. Refer servicing to qualified service personnel.
- To prevent fire or electrical shock hazard, do not expose the television receiver to rain or moisture.
- Do not drop or push objects into the television cabinet slots or openings. Never spill any kind of liquid on the television receiver.
- Never stand on, lean on, or suddenly push the television or its stand. You should pay special attention to children. Serious injury may result if it falls.
- Do not place your television on an unstable cart, stand, shelf or table. Serious injury to an individual, and damage to the television, may result if it falls.
- When the television receiver is not used for an extended period of time, it is advisable to disconnect the AC power cord from the AC outlet.


3. Press OK to enter setting.




