**Sleep and store sofa system**

When you are ready to make your sofa into a bed, first remove the bedding articles from drawer and close drawer completely. Grasp the top of the backrest near the center and pull towards you causing the backrest to rotate over, and then gently set it in the down position. Next, lift the folding legs into position, making sure they are against the stops then rotate the last section to the floor.



To inflate the airbed, you will need to remove the cover cap. **(Please note: if the cover cap is not removed and the motor is turned on, it may cause the motor to overheat and may cause a motor failure. This is NOT a warrantable issue).** After removing the cover cap, make sure the arrow is pointed to inflate mode and turn the switch on. **(Please note: The motor will not automatically turn off. Leaving the motor running after the mattress is filled may cause the motor to overheat and may cause a motor failure. This is NOT a warrantable issue.)** The airbed should inflate in less than 2 minutes.



To deflate the airbed, just turn the dial to the deflate position and turn the switch on. There is also a manual deflate port at the foot end of the mattress. Just unscrew the cover and put your finger inside the hole to flip the flap up into the inside of the airbed. If you are deflating the airbed using the manual port, you will need to close the manual port when the airbed is empty and if not completely deflated, finish by using the motor.

**(Please note: The motor will not automatically turn off. Leaving the motor running after the mattress is deflated may cause the motor to overheat and may cause a motor failure. This is NOT a warrantable issue.)** When the airbed is completely deflated, simply reverse your steps to put the bed back into sofa position. **(Please note: take all bedding and covers off the airbed when closing, and make sure all objects are clear from hinge points when rotating the backrest into the storage position. Also, make certain all the air is out. If not, either condition may cause the mechanism to not close completely or it may then hit the wall. )**



- **WARNING:** Adult supervision required for inflation and deflation
- **WARNING:** This is an electrical product - not a toy. To avoid risk of fire, burns, injury, and shock, it should not be played with by small children
- **WARNING:** The air mattress does not have a solid frame structure around edge of air mattress. Sit on edge with **caution**.
- **WARNING:** Airbed mattress & structure capacity is 450 LBS. for queen size and 400 LBS. for full size, distributed across sleeping area.
- **WARNING:** Do not use this furnishing to support video equipment such as televisions or computer monitors.
- **WARNING:** Do not use near people using or wearing medical devices.
- **CAUTION:** This device is operated with an electrically operated pump. The pump is thermal protected. The pump does not contain parts that can be repaired or serviced. Opening the pump case may expose you to electric shock.
- **DO NOT unfold or inflate the airbed in temperatures at or below freezing.**
- This mattress is not intended for infants. They may roll off of the mattress and be injured.
- Keep the cord away from heated surfaces.
- Never operate the furnishing with the air openings blocked. Keep the air opening free of lint, hair, and the like.
- DO NOT over inflate
- DO NOT obstruct ventilation hole on the pump.
- DO NOT open the pump case for any reason.
- DO NOT place any flammable material such as paper, cardboard, plastic on the pump.
- DO NOT operate the pump in enclosed space that is not well ventilated.
- DO NOT operate in the presence of explosive and /or flammable fumes.
- DO NOT place any part of the pump or cord in or under water or other liquid
- DO NOT use airbed mattress in water
- Not intended as a lifesaving device
- Keep flocked side up
- DO NOT use sharp objects around airbed mattress
- DO NOT stand or jump on mattress or use as a trampoline
- DO NOT leave device unattended when in operation.
- This mattress is made of plastic and therefore may melt or burn if it comes in contact with any flame or heat source. Do not place near or against heaters, open flame or other hot objects.
- Secure all caps and plugs
- Keep pets off
- The drawer capacity is 50 LBS., distributed in the drawer area.
- DO clean airbed with only mild soap water mixture

## NOTE

Airbed material may stretch during first use and may need additional air to reach desired firmness. Air inside of may expand and contract with vary temperatures potentially leading to reduced pressure inside of the bed. If this occurs, simply add more air using the built-in pump to achieve desired firmness.

For better protection of this product, never unfold or inflate the airbed in temperatures at or below freezing, avoid extensive expose to the sun and protect from contact with sharp objects. Make sure to handle the pump with care. Avoid pounding and jumping to prevent damage to the airbed material.

### Trouble shooting problems with your airbed mattress

#### **P=problem A=answer**

**P.** Airbed mattress is not holding air. **A.** Check all caps and valves to make sure they are closed.

**P.** Airbed is not maintaining its firmness over an extended period of time. **A.** Making sure the caps are installed tightly will help retain air longer. However, it is expected that you will need to periodically add air to keep the air mattress firm.

**P.** When folding up the bed to a sofa, it will not close. **A.** Make sure all air is completely removed from the airbed mattress and no objects are obstructing the bed from closing (even in the drawer).

**P.** The sofa tilts forward when getting in and out of bed. **A.** Make sure the sofa is secured to the floor of the RV. The sofa should be secured by a strap to the inside of the arm but no closer than 10 inches to the rear of the arm, to stop any damage to the airbed mattress when stowed.

**P.** Backrest will not rotate forward. **A.** Make sure there are no foreign objects obstructing the mechanism from moving.

**P.** I have a hole in the airbed mattress. Can I use a normal repair kit? **A.** You can use any PVC repair kit.
