SET-UP INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions for Comfort Top Airbed and **EXPRESS PUMP®** prior to inflation.

1. Carefully unpack contents from carton. Save carton for storage.

2. Place mattress in unobstructed area free of sharp objects and unfold.

NOTE: Read separate **EXPRESS PUMP®** instructions prior to operation.




3. Unscrew cap covering Comfort Top Airbed's inflate/deflate valve.

4. Locate **EXPRESS PUMP®** inflate port with arrow on valve (a).

5. Align arrow on pump with arrow on valve (b).








6. Push **EXPRESS PUMP®** firmly into valve (c).
Do not force.


7. Turn on switch to begin inflating (e).



8. Twist pump to lock into place (d). Turn on switch to begin inflating (e).




9. Inflate Airbed to full capacity. To avoid stretching or bulging do not overinflate.



10. Your Airbed is now ready to use. Replace valve cover and make up bed with standard size sheets and bedding.

TO DEFLATE AND STORE



1. Unscrew cap covering the inflate/deflate valve.

2. Locate **EXPRESS PUMP®** deflate port (g).

3. Align arrow on pump with arrow on valve (b).

4. Push **EXPRESS PUMP®** firmly into valve (h). Do not force. Twist pump to lock into place (d). Turn on switch to begin deflating (e).

5. When mattress is completely deflated turn pump off and twist pump to unlock and remove. The Comfort Top Airbed is now ready for storage.

6. Roll and return Comfort Top Airbed to its carton.



LIMITED WARRANTY

Comfort Top Airbed warrants to the original purchaser only when the **Comfort Top Airbed** is used for normal indoor temporary sleeping purposes, that the mattress will be fully guaranteed against defects in material and workmanship for a period of 90 days from the date of purchase, provided further that the **Comfort Top Airbed** has been operated and cared for according to the provided instructions and uses. Warranty does not cover punctures caused by misuse. (Included in your purchase is a repair kit)

The **EXPRESS PUMP*** will be guaranteed to the original purchaser against defects in materials and workmanship for a period of 90 days from the date of purchase provided that the pump has been operated according to the provided instructions.

Our obligation under this warranty shall be limited to the repair or exchange of any part which may prove defective under the conditions and during the periods described above.

This warranty shall not apply if upon inspection we find:

1. Any product or part has been damaged by alteration.
2. Any product or part has been subject to accident, misuse, abuse or has been operated

contrary to the provided instructions or uses.

The purchaser must obtain an authorization from a **Comfort Top Airbed** Customer Service Representative before returning a product. Upon authorization, send a copy of the original sales receipt along with a brief description of the problem to: Comfort Top Airbed, 2440 Adie Rd., St. Louis, MO 63043. To insure a timely response to ANY and ALL correspondence, PLEASE INCLUDE A DAYTIME PHONE NUMBER OR EMAIL ADDRESS WHERE YOU CAN BE REACHED. The product should be carefully packaged and delivered postage or delivery charges prepaid. The customer shall be responsible for any and all damages incurred in shipping. Repairs or replacement will be made at the company's option.

This is the entire exclusive express limited warranty. The manufacturer neither makes nor is responsible for any other warranties, either expressed or implied, including those of retailing dealers. Any and all liability for breach of warranty, as well as damages for incidental, special or consequential losses are expressly denied.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

CARE:

Mattresses are constructed of heavy duty vinyl designed for optimum comfort when used at normal household temperatures.

WARNING:

Avoid extreme cold, as vinyl will become brittle. Do not overinflate. Do not use high pressure or compressed air inflation systems. Avoid sharp objects. Do not use hair dryer to inflate.

WARNING: FLAMMABLE

VINYL IS FLAMMABLE. Do not locate bed near fire, fireplace or any other heat source, such as a space heater. Avoid placing bed over a heat emitting floor vent.

MAINTENANCE:

Clean only with mild soap and water. Harsh cleaners can damage materials. Use repair kit to patch any holes, tears or punctures. Store at room temperature only AFTER cleaned and dried. Do not store outdoors or in a garage.



PUMP INSTRUCTIONS



- ★ Power supply is 1.5V AA Batteries (8 total).
- ★ This pump is intended to inflate/deflate an Express Bed only. It is not designed for continuous use.
- ★ Extended operation over 10 minutes can overheat and damage the pump.
- ★ Keep the air pump out of reach of Children.
- ★ Do not obstruct the inflation/deflation ports and keep them ventilated at all times.
- ★ Indoor Household use only.
- ★ Do not attempt to alter or modify the pump in any way for use with other inflatable's. Doing so will void the warranty.

WARNING:

- ★ Carefully follow instructions of the mattress to be inflated. Never exceed recommended pressure. Bursting items can cause serious injury.
- ★ Never leave the pump unattended during use.
- ★ Do not keep/use the pump in wet conditions.
- ★ Never allow sand, small rocks, etc. to be sucked into the inflation/deflation port when pump is in use.
- ★ Never look inside or point the inflation/deflation port toward your eyes while the pump is working.
- ★ Never attempt to put hand or fingers into the inflation/deflation ports at any time.
- ★ When not in use, store the pump indoors. Do not expose the pump to rain, water or high-risk areas.

MODEL: EXP-127 PUMP INSTRUCTIONS


TO INFLATE EXPRESS BED:

- ★ Unscrew cap covering the inflate/deflate valve on the bed.
- ★ Locate pump inflate port.
- ★ Align arrow on pump with arrow on valve.
- ★ Push pump firmly into valve. Do not force it on.
- ★ Twist pump to lock onto valve.
- ★ Turn on the pump to begin inflating.
- ★ Inflate bed to full capacity. To avoid stretching or bulging, do not over inflate.
- ★ The valve of the Express Bed should not be obstructed. Otherwise, it could overheat and damage the pump.
- ★ Never use the deflation port when inflating the Express Bed.
- ★ The pump should fit directly on to the Express Bed Valve.



TO DEFFLATE EXPRESS BED:

- ★ Unscrew cap covering the inflate/deflate valve on the bed.
- ★ Locate pump deflate port.
- ★ Align arrow on pump with arrow on valve.
- ★ Push pump firmly into valve. Do not force it on.
- ★ Twist pump to lock onto valve.
- ★ Turn on the pump to begin deflating.
- ★ The Express Bed valve should not be obstructed . Otherwise, it could overheat and damage the pump.



CAUTION: Pump will burn out if left in "ON" position after mattress is deflated. Monitor deflation progress.
DO NOT LEAVE PUMP UNATTENDED.
